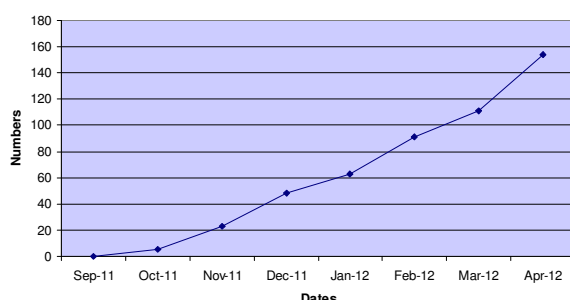

SCOR cases entered



Since the pilot commenced at the end of September 2011, a total of 154 cases have been inputted to date.

Feedback about the number and quality of submissions has been sent to individual units during March 2012.

NB: Remember to complete cases – You can use the *Incomplete* button in the Browse page to search for cases where there are missing data. When **all** fields have been completed, tick the box in the banner: *SCOR Record Complete*.

New features for next upgrade (planned during May 2012):

- **Search function** to identify hospitals and Trusts / Health Boards from a national list.
- **Changes** to question order and format in PDN *Mother* and *Baby* tabs.
- **New question** (Q19) in Antenatal *Fetal Complications* tab on management of maternal concern for the baby.
- **PDF** printing options (full and summary).
- The **Additional Points** table within the *Additional Points* tab.
- Downloadable **reports** for individual Trust's collective data.

As before, we will give you 24 hours notice before SCOR will be briefly off-line for the upgrade.

Forthcoming changes:

- More downloadable **reports** for individual Trust's collective data.
- Inter trust / board completion of a case record when there has been care across trusts / boards.

Next steps

- Peer Review Panels for quality assurance will soon be commencing for multidisciplinary perinatal review teams – further details to follow.
- We will be sending out a questionnaire to help us evaluate the pilot in the coming weeks. We would be grateful if you could take the time to complete and return it.
